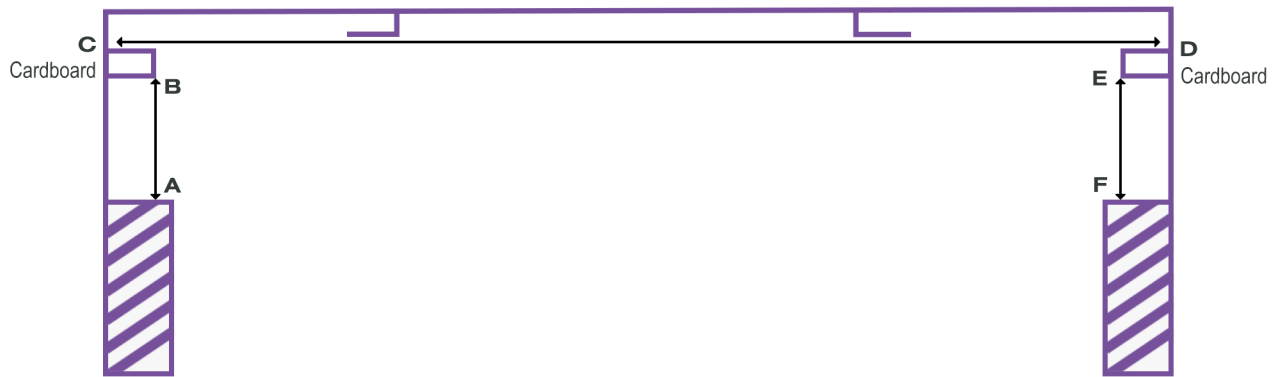


## Square Bay Window - Wood Venetian 25mm &amp; 35mm

## Square Bay Window With Recess



1. Cut a rectangular piece of cardboard 43mm deep - this will represent the headrail of your blind. Place the cardboard far enough away from the window to clear any handles as shown in the diagram.
2. Measure from points A to B and deduct 15mm to allow for clearance. This will be the exact width you require for your first blind.
3. With the cardboard in the same position, measure from point C to D and deduct 15mm for clearance. This will be the exact size you require for your second blind.
4. Then measure from point E to F and deduct 15mm for clearance. This will be the exact size you require for your third blind.
5. Measure the drop of the window in several places around the bay and use the shortest measurement.
6. When ordering your blinds, please state the sizes as 'Exact Size'. This will ensure that your blinds are manufactured to the exact sizes you have given.

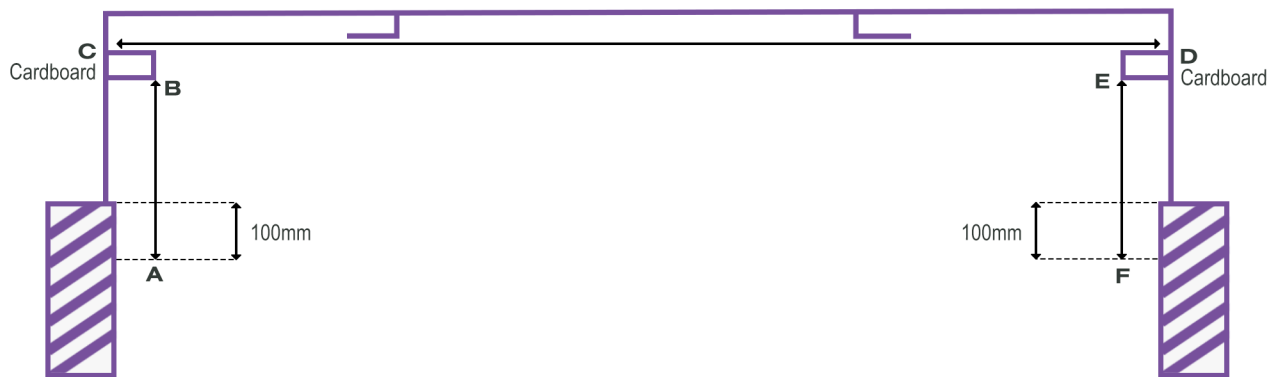
Using this guide, the exact size measurements you give us are the finished widths of the tracks and the finished drop of the blinds from the top of the bracket to the bottom of the fabric.

## Important

Never measure existing blinds that you may have in your window when ordering a completely new set of blinds - you must measure the window as if it's a blank canvas.

## Square Bay Window - Wood Venetian 25mm & 35mm

### Square Bay Window With Little or No Recess



1. Cut a rectangular piece of cardboard 43mm deep - this will represent the headrail of your blind. Place the cardboard far enough away from the window to clear any handles as shown in the diagram.
2. Measure at least 100mm into the wall as shown in the diagram. Measure from points A to B. This will be the exact width you require for your first blind.
3. With the cardboard in the same position, measure from point C to D and deduct 15mm for clearance. This will be the exact size you require for your second blind.
4. Then measure from point E to F and deduct. This will be the exact size you require for your third blind. Measure the drop of the window in several places around the bay and use the shortest measurement.

6. When ordering your blinds, please state the sizes as 'Exact Size'. This will ensure that your blinds are manufactured to the exact sizes you have given.
