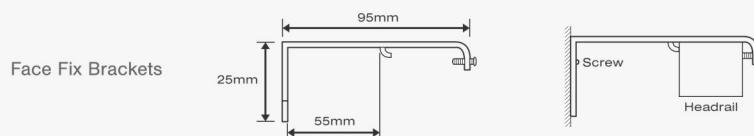


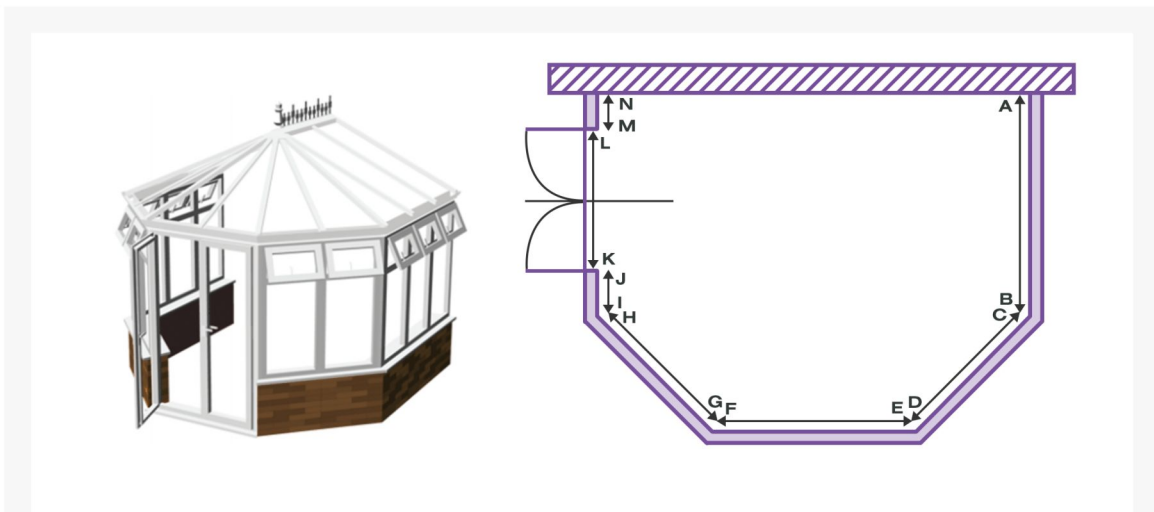
1. Firstly cut 8 cardboard pieces 95mm in depth.
2. Decide if you are fixing your blinds to the window frames or the fascias of your conservatory. Place the cardboard pieces on the window sill as shown in the diagram. If you are fixing your blinds to the fascia you need to stand the cardboard pieces off the window frame the same distance as the depth of the fascia.
3. Measure between points A and B and deduct 10mm from the measurement.
4. Measure between points C and D and use this exact measurement.
5. If the doors are at the front of your conservatory as shown in the diagram, measure between the window sill points E and F and use this exact measurement. Please note that this advice depends on exactly how your window sills are finished. Please feel free to contact us for more advice.
6. Measure between points G and H and use this exact measurement.
7. Measure between points I and J and deduct 10mm from this measurement.
8. When measuring for the drop of the blinds, measure from where you would like the top of the bracket to nish to the sill board and deduct 10mm from this measurement. We advise that you measure in several places as the drop will vary around your conservatory and always use the smallest measurement. If measuring the drop of a door blind, remember to make an extra deduction if you are placing a door mat under your blinds.
9. Always order your conservatory blinds as 'Exact Size'. Your blinds will then be manufactured to the measurements you provide and will ensure that your blinds fit correctly.



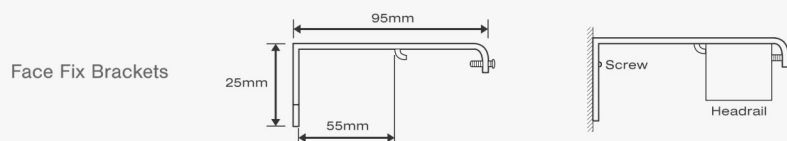
Using this guide, the exact size measurements you give us are the finished widths of the tracks and the finished drop of the blinds from the top of the bracket to the bottom of the fabric.

## Important

Never measure existing blinds that you may have in your window when ordering a completely new set of blinds - you must measure the window as if it's a blank canvas.



1. Firstly decide if you are fixing your blinds to the window frames or the facias of your conservatory. Ensure that you measure between the frames or between the facias as required. Always order conservatory blinds as 'Exact Size'. Your blinds will then be manufactured to the measurements you provide and will ensure that your blinds fit correctly.
2. Measure between points A and B and deduct 10mm from this measurement.
3. Measure between points C and D and use this exact measurement.
4. Measure between points E and F and use this exact measurement.
5. Measure between points G and H and use this exact measurement.
6. Measure between points I and J and use this exact width.
7. Measure between the sill boards, points K and L and use this exact measurement.
8. Measure between points M and N and deduct 10mm from this measurement.
9. When measuring for the drop of the blinds, measure from where you would like the top of the bracket to finish to the sill board and deduct 10mm from this measurement. We advise that you measure in several places as the drop will vary around your conservatory and always use the smallest measurement. If measuring the drop of a door blind, remember to make an extra deduction if you are placing a door mat under your blinds.
